Upon further discussion, and for all of the reasons stated in the Court's Eighteenth Court Emergency Response **Calendar Memo Order** to Novel Coronavirus Pandemic, the Court has decided to issue an Order extending certain modifications that were previously made to its Civil calendars. The Court, therefore issues this Nineteenth Court Emergency Response **Calendar Memo Order** to Novel Coronavirus Pandemic. Effective immediately:

- Remote appearances will be mandatory for the Civil judges' calendars.
- In-person appearances will only be allowed on the Civil Commissioner's 8:30 A.M. Unlawful Detainer Pre-Trial Conference calendar, 1:30 P.M. OEX calendar and Unlawful Detainer Court Trial calendars.
- Public access to the proceedings being heard in the Civil judges' courtrooms will be available by Zoom.

This Order shall remain in effect through January 31, 2022. The Court retains the authority and the discretion to alter this Order should circumstances suggest that a change is necessary.
