11 **AMENDED STANDING ORDER OF THE**  
12 **COURT APPOINTING PUBLIC GUARDIAN**  
13 **AS PROBATE CONSERVATOR AND**  
14 **AUTHORIZATION OF INDIVIDUALS TO**  
15 **EXECUTE TAX DOCUMENTATION**

16 Based upon the Ex Parte Application of Portor Goltz, Deputy County Counsel, as attorney  
17 for the Office of the San Mateo County Public Guardian, and, for good cause appearing,

18 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

19 1. That the Public Guardian for the County of San Mateo is the agency designated to serve  
20 as Probate Conservator of the Person and Estate of those individuals who are unable to meet their  
21 basic needs for physical health, food, clothing, or shelter, and/or who are unable to manage his/her  
22 own financial resources or resist fraud or undue influence when no other person is appointed to serve  
23 in that capacity. The Public Guardian for the County of San Mateo is appointed as Conservator of  
24 the Person and Estate in LPS Conservatorship proceedings when the individual under the disability of  
25 the Conservatorship is suffering from a mental illness or mental disease.

26 2. That Charlene A. Silva is the duly appointed Public Guardian for the County of San Mateo.  
27 By way of this Order, the Court hereby authorizes the individuals named in this Order to execute any  
28 document or tax return required to be filed in conjunction with a tax return with the Internal Revenue  
Service or the California State Franchise Tax Board or with any other agency designated for this

1 purpose. The individuals who are authorized to execute these documents on behalf of and in the  
2 place of Charlene A. Silva are:

8 3. That a signature of any of the above-named individuals shall have the same force and effect  
9 in relation to the above-described activities as if executed personally by Charlene A. Silva, the Public  
10 Guardian for the County of San Mateo.

11 4. That this Order shall be a Standing Order of the Court and shall remain in full force and  
12 effect until it has been revoked by the Court.



20 to sign.

21 2. Charlene A. Silva, the acting Director of Health Services for the County of San Mateo, is

23 Guardian is to execute any document or tax return required to be filed in conjunction with a tax  
24 return with the Internal Revenue Service or the California State Franchise Tax Board or with any
