

Effective July 6, 2010, *ex parte* applications in felony cases shall proceed as follows:

1. *Ex parte* applications shall be presented to the Criminal Presiding Judge in Department 2A at the Hall of Justice and Records as follows: Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Fridays, applications shall be presented between 4:00-4:30 p.m. On Thursdays, the applications should be presented between 8:00 a.m. and 8:30 a.m.
2. Each *ex parte* application shall be in writing, accompanied by a memorandum of points and authorities, a declaration making the required factual showing, and a proposed order, as provided in California Rule of Court (CRC) §§ 3.1201 and 3.1202.
3. Written notice shall be provided to opposing counsel as defined in CRC §§ 3.1203 and 3.1204.
