**STANDING ORDER RE: APPOINTMENT OF PUBLIC GUARDIAN
AND APPOINTMENT OF PUBLIC GUARDIAN AS PROBATE CONSERVATOR AND
AUTHORIZATION OF INDIVIDUALS TO EXECUTE DOCUMENTS
AND TAX RETURNS OF PERSONS**

Based upon the exparte application of Steven L. Dylina, Deputy County Counsel as attorney for the office of the Public Guardian for the County of San Mateo; and

GOOD CAUSE APPEARING THEREFOR, THE COURT FINDS AND HEREBY ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Public Guardian for the County of San Mateo is the agency designated to serve as Probate Conservator of the person and estate of those individuals who are unable to meet their basic needs of food, clothing and shelter and who are unable to understand the nature and extent of their estate or to resist undue influence when no other person is appointed to serve in that capacity. The Public Guardian is appointed as conservator of the person and estate in LPS Conservatorship proceedings when the individual under the conservatorship is suffering from a mental illness or mental disease.
2. Margaret Taylor, is the duly appointed Public Guardian for the County of San Mateo. By way of this order the Court hereby authorizes the individuals named in this order to execute any document or tax return required to be filed in conjunction with a tax return with the Internal Revenue Service or with the California State Franchise Tax Board or with any other agency designated for this purpose. The individuals who are authorized to execute these documents and/or returns on behalf of and in the place of Margaret Taylor are:

3. Signature of any of the above-named individuals shall have the same force and effect in relation to the above-described tax returns or related documents as if executed personally by Margaret Taylor, the Public Guardian for the County of San Mateo.

This order shall supersede any previous order(s) and shall remain in effect indefinitely and until such time as the order is vacated or superseded by the Presiding Judge.

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16 I, STEVEN L. DYLINE, declare as follows:

17 1. This application for an ex parte standing order is made on behalf of the Public Guardian
18 for the County of San Mateo in relation to the Probate Conservatorship and LPS Conservatorship cases
19 now pending before the Court.

20 2. Margaret Taylor, the Director of Public Health for the County of San Mateo is also
21 designated Public Guardian for the county of San Mateo. Part of the responsibility of the Public
22 Guardian is to file tax returns, where appropriate, for those individuals currently under either a Probate
23 Conservatorship or an LPS Conservatorship.

24 3. The State Franchise Tax Board and Internal Revenue Service have refused to accept
25 these documents which have been signed by Mr. Tito De la Cruz, who is the Finance Director for the
26 San Mateo County Department of Health Services.

27 4. This application is made to the Court seeking a standing order which will allow the
28 individuals listed below to sign the more than four hundred (400) tax returns which must be completed


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1 and mailed prior to April 15, each year. This application is made with the knowledge of and at the
