



## Driving Under the Influence (DUI) Programs

Contact the DUI treatment program of your choice to schedule an intake appointment as soon as possible to avoid possible setbacks. You **MUST** enroll at the agency of your choice within the set deadline that was ordered by the court judge during your initial court hearing, if applicable. **ABSTAIN FROM ALCOHOL AND/OR DRUGS.** Court or DMV document are required as proof to begin the enrollment process. All programs are licensed by the Department of Health Care Services and approved by the County of San Mateo Health, Behavioral Health & Recovery Services Division, Alcohol & Other Drug Services. Contact each program to inquire the days and time that DUI classes are held. **ALL** DUI treatment programs offer English and Spanish-speaking classes and provided remotely.
