Step 1:

START YOUR CASE WITH THE COURT



Fill out these forms, and make copies:

- Petition (<u>FL-100</u>) (+ 2 copies)
- Summons (<u>FL-110</u>) (+ 2 copies)
- UCCJEA Declaration (FL-105) if you have minor children together (+ 2 copies)
- Fee Waiver forms if low income: **FW-001** and **FW-003** (+ 1 copy)

File these forms at the clerk's window. The clerk will give you back your copies, stamped. One copy is for you. One copy is for the other side.

Step 2:

LET THE OTHER SIDE KNOW, IN PERSON




This is called Service and you can't do it yourself.

- Have someone 18 or older give the other side in person copies of: FL-100, FL-110, (FL-105 if you used it); include a blank response (FL-120) (and a blank FL-105, if you used it).
- Have that person (the server) fill out Proof of Service of Summons (FL-115).
- File the completed Proof of Service of Summons (<u>FL-115</u>) with the court (+ 1 copy).
- Your spouse has 30 days to file a Response (FL-120) in court.

Step 3:

EXCHANGE FINANCIAL INFORMATION



You can do this at the same time as Step 1. You must do this within 60 days of Step 1.

- Declaration of Disclosure (FL-140)
- Schedule of Assets and Debts (FL-142) or Property Declaration (FL-160)
- Income & Expense Declaration (FL-150)
- Serve the other side a completed set (keep the original), and a blank set.
- Tell the court you did this: Declaration re. Service of Decl. of Disclosure (<u>FL-141</u>).
 This is the only form you file at court for this step.
