MINIMUM/MAXIMUM PENALTY

Probation Granted: not less than 5 nor more than 90 days in County Jail or a fine of not less than \$145 nor more than \$1,000 fine (plus assessments) or both fine and imprisonment and participation in and completion of at minimum the educational component of an alcohol and drug education program

I understand that if I am charged with 23103 under 23103.5 of the Vehicle Code, a plea of guilty/nolo contendere to that charge will be considered a prior conviction to enhance the penalties under V.C. Sections 23152 and/or 23153 if the commission of said offense(s) occurs within seven (7) years of the commission of this offense.

I understand that I will be ordered to make restitution to the victim, if the offense involved a victim and that the restitution order shall be enforceable as a civil judgment. I understand that a restitution fine of not less than \$100 or more than \$1000 will also be imposed.

If applicable, I understand that, if I am subsequently convicted of a misdemeanor violation of VC Section 12500(a), 14601, 14601.1, 14601.2, 14601.3, 14601.4, or 14601.5, pursuant to VC Section 14607.6 a motor vehicle is subject to forfeiture as a nuisance if it is driven on a highway by a driver with a suspended or revoked license, or by an unlicensed driver who is the registered owner of the vehicle who has a previous misdemeanor conviction of any one of these sections.

If applicable, I understand that if I am convicted of a violation of Vehicle Code section 14601.2, the Court will require me to install an Ignition Interlock Device (IID) on any vehicle that I own or operate for a period of up to three years. Installation of this device, which prevents the vehicle from starting if I have alcohol in my body, DOES NOT AUTHORIZE ME TO DRIVE WITHOUT A VALID DRIVER'S LICENSE. Failure to install the Ignition Interlock Device shall result in the suspension of my driver's license by the Department of Motor Vehicles.

I understand that if I am not a citizen, a conviction of the offense for which I have been charged may have the consequences of deportation, exclusion from admission to the United States, or denial of naturalization pursuant to the laws of the United States.

If applicable - I understand that I have the right to enter my plea before, and be sentenced by a judge. I give up this right and agree to enter my plea before, and be sentenced by \_\_\_\_\_, Temporary Judge.
