NOTICE REGARDING OFFICIAL COURT REPORTERS

San Mateo County Superior Court provides official court reporters to transcribe the verbatim record of court proceedings in certain cases as provided by statute, California Rules of Court, and Local Rules 2.12 and 9.12.
